AMENDED NOISE ORDINANCE  
MARION TOWNSHIP ORDINANCE NO. 2023-3

Under the authority provided in Minnesota Statutes Section 368.01, Subd. 19, THE TOWN BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF MARION ORDAINS:

Subdivision 1. General Noise. No person shall make, continue, or cause to be made or continued any loud, unnecessary or unusual noise which unreasonably annoys, disturbs, injures, or endangers the comfort, convenience, safety, health, welfare, or repose of persons in the vicinity thereof, unless the making, continuing or causing to be made or continued of such noise:

1. Cannot be prevented;
2. Is necessary for the protection or preservation of property;
3. Is necessary for the protection or preservation of the health, safety, life or limb or same person; or
4. Occurs as a result of generally recognized farming operations or practices.


Subdivision 2. Animals. No person shall keep any animal which makes, continues, or causes to be made or continued any loud, unnecessary or unusual noise which unreasonably annoys, disturbs, injures, or endangers the comfort, convenience, safety, health, welfare, or repose of persons in the vicinity thereof.


Subdivision 3. Penalties. Any person violating any provision of this Ordinance shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor and punished by a fine not exceeding the maximum limit established by Minnesota Statutes for the punishment of misdemeanors or imprisonment in the Olmsted County Jail for a period not exceeding 90 days. Each day's violation shall be a separate offense. The costs incurred by the Town of Marion, including attorney's fees in prosecuting violations of this Ordinance, shall be added to the sentence of any person determined to be guilty for a violation of this Ordinance.

Subdivision 4. Amendment. This Ordinance amends the Town of Marion's Noise Ordinance dated June 11, 1991, by adding Subd. 3.


This Amended Noise Ordinance is adopted by the Marion Town Board of Supervisors this 13<sup>th</sup> day of June, 2023.
